#### EMPLOYER INCENTIVES

We cover clients' salaries and workers compensation insurance for an agreed number of hours (usually up to 40 hours). Job coaches ensure work safety, quality and quantity.

Employers have the opportunity to experience the clients' capabilities and contributions during this internship with the possibility of long-term employees after this experience. The majority of the funding for this comes from government agencies.
